AS NOTED IN OUR LETTER OF FEBRUARY 11, 1982, TO SECRETARY WATT, VVMF WILL DEVELOP THE SPECIFICS OF THESE REFINEMENTS AND SEPARATELY SUBMIT THEM FOR APPROVAL. HOWEVER, I URGE YOU TO APPROVE TODAY, AS REQUESTED BY SECRETARY WATT, THE CONCEPT

AS YOU MAY KNOW, VVMF IS A NONPROFIT, CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION FOUNDED, DIRECTED, AND MANAGED BY VIETNAM VETERANS. WE OBTAINED THE DESIGN CONCEPT FOR THE MEMORIAL THROUGH THE METHOD OF A DESIGN COMPETITION, WHICH BECAME THE LARGEST EVER HELD IN THE UNITED STATES. WE HAVE BEEN EXTREMELY ENTHUSIASTIC ABOUT THE CONCEPT, AND WE WERE GRATIFIED THAT IT RECEIVED YOUR SWIFT APPROVAL AS WELL AS THAT OF THE COMMISSION OF FINE ARTS AND THE NATIONAL CAPITAL MEMORIAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE. WE WERE ALSO GRATIFIED THAT NUMEROUS CORPORATIONS, THE MAJOR VETERANS ORGANIZATIONS, AND HUNDREDS OF THOUSANDS OF INDIVIDUAL AMERICANS CONTRIBUTED THE FUNDS TO REALIZE THE CONCEPT.

NONETHELESS, THE DESIGN SPARKED CONTROVERSY,
ARTICULARLY AMONG OUR BROTHER VIETNAM VETERANS.
HE BASIC CRITICISM CENTERED NOT SO MUCH ON WHAT
HE DESIGN WAS BUT ON THE FACT THAT IT LACKED ELEMENTS
PECIFICALLY SYMBOLIC OF THE HONORABLE SERVICE
F THE VETERANS AND OF THEIR DEVOTION TO COUNTRY.
T BECAME APPARENT TO VVMF THAT THESE CONCERNS
AD MERIT AND NEEDED TO BE ADDRESSED.

THUSLY, WE REQUESTED SENATOR JOHN WARNER OF IRGINIA, ONE OF THE EARLIEST AND MOST DEDICATED DNGRESSIONAL SUPPORTERS OF THE PROJECT, TO ARANGE ND MODERATE A MEETING AMONG VVMF AND THE LEADING RITICS OF THE DESIGN, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF CONGRESS, O ATTEMPT TO ACCOMMCDATE THEIR CONCERNS. AFTER ENGTHY DISCUSSION, AND WITH THE COURAGEOUS LEADERSHIP F SENATOR WARNER, A CONSENSUS OF AGREEMENT WAS CHIEVED BY WHICH WE HOPE TO MOVE AHEAD ON SCHEDULE OWARD COMPLETION OF A SUPERB TRIBUTE TO VIETNAM ETERANS. UNDER THE CONSENSUS, VVMF AGREED TO ODIFY THE WORDING OF THE INSCRIPTION SO AS TO ORE STRONGLY EXPRESS HONOR FOR VIETNAM VETERANS, ND TO ADD A FLAG STAFF AND A STATUE OF A SERVICEMAN T THE SITE. IN TURN, THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ASIC DESIGN THAT HAD ALREADY BEEN APPROVED WOULD OVE FORWARD ON SCHEDULE.

LAST MONTH WE MET WITH SECRETARY WATT TO EXPLAIN
HE AGREEMENT. HE EXPRESSED HIS PLEASURE THAT
N ACCOMMODATION HAD BEEN REACHED AND INDICATED
IS OWN WILLINGNESS TO SUPPORT THE BASIC DESIGN
ND THE CONCEPTS OF THE ADDITIONAL REFINEMENTS.
OWEVER, AS THESE REFINEMENTS ARE BY LAW SUBJECT
O THE APPROVAL OF THIS COMMISSION, SECRETARY WATT,
EFORE ISSUING A CONSTRUCTION PERMIT, NOW SEEKS
OUR ACCEPTANCE OF THEM IN CONCEPT. THUSLY, WE

ORIAL CAN BE BROKEN THIS MONTH AS SCHEDULED.

WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT A FLAG AND STATUE CAN INTEGRATED WITH THE BASIC DESIGN SO AS TO HARMONIZE TH AND ENHANCE ITS BEAUTY AND SIMPLICITY. WE 'E BEGUN TO EVALUATE ALTERNATE PROPOSALS FOR E FLAG AND STAFF. FURTHERMORE, WE HAVE REVIEWED \_ THE ENTRIES IN THE DESIGN COMPETITION AND HAVE \_LED OUT AND CIRCULATED ALL CONTAINING WORKS SCULPTURE. SENATOR WARNER WILL CHAIR A MEETING IS MONTH TO DISCUSS THESE ENTRIES AND ATTEMPT IDENTIFY ONE OR MORE ARTISTS WHO WILL BE INVITED SUBMIT CONCEPTUAL MODELS. WHEN THE SPECIFICS R REFINEMENTS ARE DEVELOPED, THEY WILL BE SUBMITTED YOU FOR YOUR DETAILED REVIEW AND APPROVAL. WE MAN TO COMPLETE THE PROCESS OF DEVELOPMENT AND IVIEW SO THAT ALL ELEMENTS CAN BE COMPLETED FOR DEDICATION OF THE MEMORIAL ON VETERANS DAY THIS DVEMBER. YET, YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONCEPT - THESE REFINEMENTS IS NEEDED TODAY IN ORDER THAT DNSTRUCTION OF THE BASIC DESIGN MAY BE BEGUN THIS ONTH AND COMPLETED BY THAT TIME.
